**Chester Turnpike**

Mr. Ranfos and residents from Chester Turnpike reviewed and discussed a petition presented to the Board, re: excessive speed, loud exhaust, etc. Resident, Mr. Prince, stated if speed bumps were not an option that he would like to see the road as an exit only or limited time uses of the road. Sandy stated that the park, police and the Board should work together and come up with a solution. Sandy stated that the Board will discuss this and get back to the residents. This issue was discussed and considered in 1996 and the Board wants to review that information.

**2007 Building & Health Budget**

Carol seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

**2007 Welfare & Health Agency Budgets**

The BOS and Kelley discussed the Welfare and Health Agency budgets. Motion made by Peter to accept the bottom line of \$59,950.00, Welfare. Carol seconded. Motion passed 3-0. Motion made by Peter to accept the bottom line of \$29,122.00, Health Agency budget. Carol seconded. Motion passed 3-0. Note: the Board added \$100.00 for Capital Area Transit (CAT) which is a new agency this year.

Board is taking these issues under advisement until next BOS meeting on October 2, 2006.

**May 2006 Flooding**

Board discussed waiving building permit fees for victims. The Board will consider waiving building permit fees for the victims of the May flooding based on hardship and upon written request.

**Assessing Floor**

The floor in the Assessing office continues to sag. Kelley received a proposal from the HL Turner group for \$3890 to do the whole structural plan.
