Minutes

Chief stated that there would have to be a public hearing prior to adopting the ordinance. A Public Hearing on re-numbering sections of Spring Street will be held on November 27, 2006.

Emergency Management Grant

Chief Mulholland discussed with the Board an Emergency Management Exercise Grant of over \$50,000.00 dollars. Chief discussed the details of the grant and he would like the Board to approve and sign the appropriate paper work.

Highway Safety Grant
